

- ◆ **Clinical Care** An overall review of LLGAMH's programs and services will be part of our upcoming strategic planning process. Programs such as the diabetic foot care clinic demonstrate our ability to respond to the needs within our community.
- ◆ **Building Our Culture** LLGAMH's values were confirmed in July 2020, involving more than 40 staff members. A committee is now reviewing our ICARE behaviours, looking at new ways of recognition and celebration.
- ◆ **Enhancing Partnerships** We continue to collaborate with our partners to support local communities. We are a founding member in the Lanark, Leeds, and Grenville Ontario Health team. One of the goals for year one is better connections to mental health resources. We are also working with Lanark County and United Counties of Leeds and Grenville to better understand the housing, homelessness, and health needs of vulnerable populations.

- ◆ In 2020/2021, LLGAMH provided care and services to over 4,500 clients who reach out for help with depression, anxiety, substance use, family and relationships, challenges, grief, trauma, and housing.

We are pleased to report that the auditors noted that there were no deficiencies last year (2019/20) or this year (2020/21) compared to the audit two years ago when there were significant concerns. The agency ended the 2020/21 year with a small surplus.
